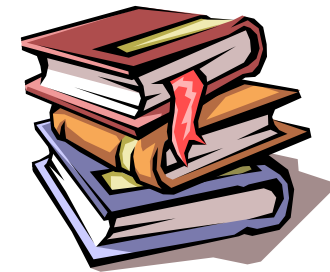

We have a small collection of published and unpublished records for various towns.

Cemetery Records

For most of Chenango county we have published & unpublished records.

For Broome & Madison counties we have a small number of unpublished records.

Census Records

New York State 1790 and Index for 1800.

Various 19th century Chenango county censuses in print through 1855

We also have 1855, 1860, 1880, 1900, 1910, 1920, and 1930 on microfilm.

Family Folders

Our genealogical family folder collection contains 1,870 surnames and 1,576 family folders. The family files were started when the library received a donation of genealogical notes & research compiled by Gertrude Howard Smith. Since then we have continued to add to this collection by our own research and donations from visiting patrons.

Chenango County Directories 1869-70 and 1902

These contain villages and towns found in Chenango County, New York.

Genealogical Resource Books

These volumes can assist the researcher in locating records, how to document materials and write their family history.

Guernsey Memorial Library Photograph Collection

Post Card Collection

Approximately 191 postcards with views of Norwich and surrounding areas.

Glen Buell Photograph Collection Volumes 1-5

These volumes contain views of Norwich and her citizens from around the late 1800's to middle 1900's.

Miss Robb's Scrapbooks

There are two sets of scrapbooks. The first has newspaper clippings for 1960-1970 and is labeled volumes A-G with an index. The second is newspaper clippings covering 1933-1962 and is labeled

volumes 1-18 with an index.

World War II Veterans Books 39 Volumes

A listing of Chenango county service men and women, compiled by Nellie Johnson, Co. Historian and DAR member and many volunteers. These records contain service papers and newspaper clippings from Chenango county newspapers. Photographs of service men and women appear in five scrapbooks.

Obituary Collection

There are 100 plus books with individual indexes. The collection was started in 1981 when the obituaries were clipped from our local newspaper. Years prior to 1981 were obtained through donations and our research.

Master Index for Obituaries

Volumes 1-90 that also include the Glen Buell Newspaper Collection Deaths only.

Glen Buell Newspaper Collection

Volumes 1-9 are taken from the back page of the Saturday Utica Globe Newspaper covering 1900-1916. Contains general news of Norwich, births, deaths, marriages & divorces. Indexes are in front of photocopied volumes.

Tucker's Scrapbooks

There are 12 scrapbooks with an index to births, deaths & marriages from the 1930's - 1940's.

DAR Lineage Books

Volumes 1 - 141 with indexes.

Short Stories of Chenango County
